Paper recycling begins with you. You can recycle magazines, catalogs, newspapers, school papers and mail. If it's paper and it tears, it's probably recyclable paper.

MARKETPLACE

The newly printed newspaper and magazines are distributed. You could be reading news from the same paper that you recycled just 2 weeks ago.

DROP OFF

Take your paper to your local Paper Retriever recycling bin. We pay the host organization for all the paper collected in the bin.



PAPER PRODUCTS

Then the paper is packed in cartons or rolls and is ready for shipment to local printers, newspapers, magazines, offices, packaging manufacturers and others.

COLLECTION

The bin is emptied by a specially designed truck and the paper is delivered to a nearby processing center.

RECYCLING PROCESS

Adding warm water and soap causes the papers to break apart into small fibers. Big rollers iron out the paper, remove the moisture and then the paper is wound into big rolls.
